Application deadline is August 15, 2022.

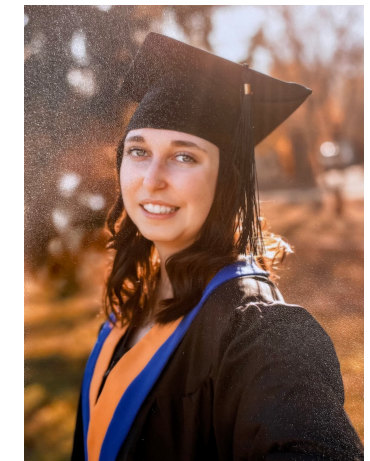
## Kerrobert Credit union 2022 Bursary Winners
