Kerrobert Credit Union has served the community of Kerrobert since 1963, and in 1975, that commitment to service was extended to the community of Major. How has the credit union served these communities for 58 years?

Our primary means of serving our community is as a financial institution with a brick and mortar building. The products and services that we offer members began with a simple chequing and savings account but has evolved to registered plan accounts and US chequing accounts. We offer loan products for consumers, commercial and agricultural members. We have automatic payment options, wire transfers, Interac e-Transfers, Deposit Anywhere (cheque deposit via our mobile app) and our most recent service - International Transfers. We also host a variety of credit card options for business and personal accounts, including a US credit card. Over the years, we have adopted new products and services as required to fit the needs of our members.

However, a huge part of serving the community is what we have done, and continue to do, to give back to these communities. Over the course of these 58 years, the Credit Union has donated funds to community events and facilities, and assisted organizations in fundraising projects. Over the last 10 years, we have averaged over \$30,000 in annual donations. Along with financial donations, our staff members have been visible in the community by volunteering at different functions, such as dinner theatre, bursaries to students. selling 50/50 tickets at hockey games and delivering meals with the Meals on Wheels program. In total, they have given back over 800 volunteer hours in our communities over the last two years.

It is important to highlight the support we have provided to our community. We donated **\$50,000** to KLD Wellness in the commitment for the new hospital. We support the Golf Course with hole sponsors, new tarps, and annual golf cart

sponsorships in a value of over **\$12,000**. We have assisted the Pioneers Haven with donations in excess of \$12,000. We purchased and installed the score clock at the hockey rink for **\$21,700** and provided annual team sponsorships to the West Central Rage, Kerrobert Tigers and Minor Hockey teams averaging over **\$2,000** each year. Our Credit Union has supported the Curling Club with bonspiel prizes and house advertising over **\$500** each year. In 2019, we gave the swimming changed and grown with the times while pool **\$10,000** for their upgrade project. During the Centennial Celebrations, the Credit Union paid for the entertainment so the community could attend the dance I would like to thank our communities free of charge, and staff assisted with serving the pancake breakfast. Kerrobert to serve and for the continued support. Minor Ball benefited from a \$3,000 donation for diamond upgrades and a sports day event. The Kerrobert & District and benefit from what our community Agricultural Society was given \$25,000 toward the construction of their building at the fairgrounds. The Kerrobert Rodeo has received sponsorship of \$500 for several years to host their events. The Prairieland Players received donations to help with the costs of performances, and our staff volunteered during the evening as hosts. We helped the Kerrobert Fire Department to purchase a new water truck with a \$2,500 donation and assisted the Kerrobert Daycare to install new windows with a **\$5,000** donation. Over the last three years, we have been able to support the Kerrobert Composite School with Fruit Fridays by funding the healthy snack for **\$1,600** per year and when possible, staff members help serve them to the students. In addition to supporting

all these worthwhile projects, events, and organizations, since 1991 our Credit Union has provided the opportunity for graduating students to apply for a bursary to support their continuing education. As of 2021, we have awarded **\$64,100** in

In the community of Major, we have donated over \$500 a year to their annual Redneck games and donated prizes and team sponsorship for numerous curling bonspiels. We also contributed to their hall renovation project by helping fund fundraising efforts and donated an AED machine to the Fire Department.

We continue to look for ways to serve our community. Just recently, we offered

free swimming weekends in June and July, and have arranged to offer this again for the August long weekend. We have plans for more community support of our facilities, organizations and community events, so watch for ads on our social media pages and in the weekly Chronicle.

Since our humble beginnings, we have moved into new buildings, hired new people, and adopted new products, services and technology. We have working with our community to meet the needs of our membership.

for all the opportunities we have had Our board and staff live and work in these communities, participate in events offers, the same as our members do. All decisions are made locally with the understanding that when our community supports the Kerrobert Credit Union, the Kerrobert Credit Union can support our community.
